



This is the Privacy Policy of LIMOT Elektromotorenbauges.m.b.H & Co KG.

We undertake to protect the privacy of your personal data. Please read the following privacy policy in order to understand how we collect and use your personal data when you get in contact with us, visit our websites, apply for a job with us, or order our products or services.

When you send personal data to us, you agree to its collection and use according to this data protection statement.

What personal data will be collected and how will it be used?

We collect data such as names, job titles, company addresses, telephone numbers, fax numbers and email addresses. These personal data are collected for the purpose for which they have been provided, in accordance with this policy.

Account management

If you obtain products or services from us, or vice versa, we will use your contact details and payment information for the purposes of account management, order processing and invoicing, and maintenance of our corporate accounts and company records.

LIMOT App

Email policies

We will ensure that our email communications comply with the following requirements:

- You can unsubscribe from any mailing list except for emails relating to legal notices and invoicing.

Job applications

If you submit a job application or enquiry including your CV and other relevant information, we may use these for the purposes of assessing your application or enquiry and store them as computer files. This shall apply unless you explicitly request the return of the documents with the instruction that they may not be stored.



With whom will we share your personal data?

If we receive requests from government agencies, authorities or other official bodies, we will pass on your information only if we are legally obligated to do so.

Exceptions

We shall not store your personal data in any other ways than those described above unless we need to do so to enforce our rights.

This data protection statement applies to personal data collected by us. Web analytics
